

BEAR IN MIND

WE LIVE IN BEAR COUNTRY

Feeding wildlife, even unintentionally, is against the law!

-  Keep all garbage, food scraps and recyclables in a secure location
-  Keep enclosure door locked at all times
-  Always secure locks on carts/containers
-  Freeze odorous items (meat, fish, bones) until collection morning
-  Diapers and meat grease are strong attractants, keep inside home until collection morning
-  Keep enclosure clean and tidy

Daytime bear activity is normal. If bears find unnatural food they may be active over the winter. Taking these steps year-round will help to reduce a bear's reason for being close to homes. Bears that find food from humans are often killed. Help to keep bears safe.
